Step 4Your pets require a Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC) completed by your family vet the day before departure. Our consulting vet can complete the VHC on your behalf by prior arrangement. Dogs must be treated for internal and external parasites (specifically Echinococcus Multilocularis) on the same day. Validity of the VHC is 24 (twenty-four) hours and must be valid on arrival.				
Step 5	Submission to Petwings	The following documents must be submitted to Petwings:1. Original, unaltered vaccination booklet for each pet2. Original microchip certificate for each pet3. 1 Original Veterinary Health Certificate for each pet4. Import Permit (Copy)5. Original Rabies Neutralising Antibody Titre Test (RNATT)(Microchip ID must be noted on all the above documents)On the day of departure Petwings will submit these documents to the South AfricanState Vet for certification and endorsement.		
Step 6	Clearance at destination (We can advise you)	It is advised that your pets arrive at their destination during the week and preferably during normal office hours. This will ensure timely clearance through Customs and the presiding State Vet while avoiding additional charges. Where applicable and unless stated otherwise, the consignee is responsible for import Permit, Import Customs, and Clearance at destination.		
Other important notes to consider				
<ul> <li>Puppies and kittens may not travel to Bahrain on their dam's vaccinations.</li> <li>Their first Rabies vaccination must be administered at 12 (twelve) weeks of age (3 months), followed by a booster vaccination 30 (thirty) days later and then they can start the export procedure.</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>For your pet's comfort during travel we encourage you to include a favourite blanket, soft toy, or old T-shirt with your scent which we will place in their travel box.</li> <li>Chemical and other strong sedatives are NOT ALLOWED.</li> <li>Mild herbal remedies such as Rescue, CalmEze, catnip spray or other valerian root extracts are permitted.</li> </ul> Please inform your Petwings consultant of any brachycephalic (snub nose) pets travelling as certain airline,
